FACTORY REAR BAR REMOVAL

- Begin by disconnecting the OE end links form both ends of the rear bar. Note: The end links will be re-used to install the new Eibach rear bar
- Next remove the frame mount bushing brackets securing the bar to the rear axle. Note: The brackets will be re-used to install the new Eibach rear bar.
- 3. Now remove the rear bar.
- 4. order of disassembly.

EIBACH REAR BAR INSTALLATION

- Apply some poly lubricant to the inside of the new rear bushings and install both bushings on the bar.
- 2. Installation of the new Eibach rear bar is the reverse order of disassembly.
